Our Staff Stars Of The Week this week are Arthur Simpson and Nathan Kelly who went above and beyond to ensure students arrived home safely after Parents Evening.

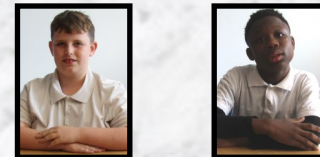
