As part of our ongoing Quality Assurance of every aspect of the provision here at Cambridge School, we commissioned a Safeguarding Audit by an independent consultant, Ella Savell-Boss in September. We received the report this week after a very rigorous process of scrutiny. Ella interviewed parents, staff and governors as well as pupils to really get under the skin of our school and to live and breathe our culture and values. She has given us an action plan to make some minor changes to improve our policies and procedures which will make safeguarding even more robust. It is really helpful to get constructive criticism like this in an Ofsted year as we strive for excellence. It is even more pleasing to receive some glowing comments about the school which I want to share with you.

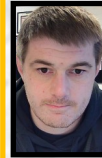

Our Staff Star Of The Week is Harry for stepping up and doing a great job covering PE whilst staff were on a 1st Aid course. Well done!

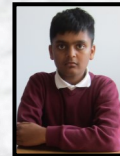
