It is my New Year resolution to work as hard as I can to make this our most successful year yet at Cambridge School. Happy New Year!!

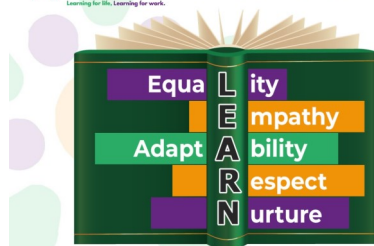
