Where students are not making the expected or required progress, we are putting in targeted interventions, particularly in reading as this is the key to success, unlocking the curriculum in every aspect.

Have a lovely and relaxing weekend.

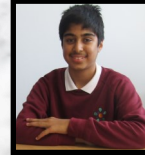
